Our purpose is to foster ideas that will be fundamental in the development of liberty.

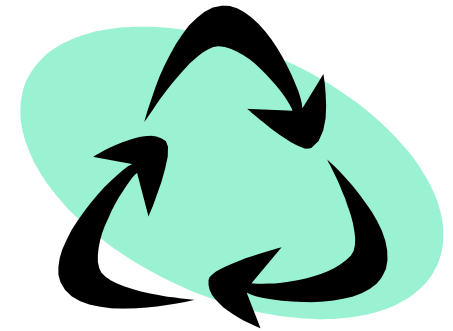
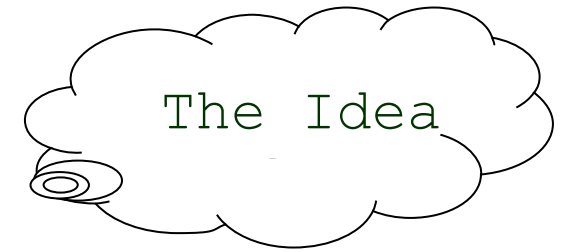
